

GLOBAL HEALTH PROTECTION PROGRAMME (GHPP)- REGTRAIN



The Food and Drugs Authority (FDA) Ghana has collaborated with the German Federal Ministry of Health in its initiative dubbed the Global Health Protection program (GHPP)- Reg Train.

The Regtrain is a capacity building programme which covers regulatory activities in the areas of Clinical Trials, pharmacovigilance and Marketing Authorization. Selected Staff from the FDA will be trained in specific regulatory topics which are expected to increase staff competency level, improve their work and strengthen regulatory activities in accordance with international best practice.

A kick off meeting was held in Accra from 7th -9th May 2019 between FDA and partner institutions: Paul-Ehrlich-Institut (PEI) and the Federal Institute for regulation of Medicines and Medical Devices (BfArM) to discuss the training needs, plan, curricular and selection process for regulators to partake in the training.
