



CENTRAL REGIONAL OFFICE OF THE FDA ORGANIZES SAFE DISPOSAL OF PRODUCTS

As part of its mandate to ensure Public Health and safety in accordance with the Public Health Act, 2012, Act 851, the Central Regional office of the Food and Drugs Authority, in collaboration with the Cape Coast Metropolitan Assembly, supervised the safe disposal of **3.689 tonnes** of assorted drugs, food, cosmetics, household chemicals and medical devices amounting to about Fifty Thousand, Six Hundred and Eighty Five Ghana Cedis (**GH¢ 50,685.00**) in accordance with the Public Health Act, 2012.

The products that were safely disposed of were made up of unregistered, expired, falsely labelled or unwholesome products which had been seized from January 2019 to April 2019. Some were seized during PMS activities and voluntary submission of Products by clients.
