

FDA ORGANISES TRAINING ON FOOD SAFETY

As part of efforts by the FDA to equip the Food Industry with the requisite knowledge to ensure food safety within the Food Service Establishment, a training program was held in Wa for members of the food industry on the 30th April 2019.

The one day training, which also aimed at minimizing infractions observed during the FDA's food safety audit, covered a number of topical issues including basic microbiology, pest control, waste management and other relevant issues and was attended by 24 participants from 10 food establishments.

Participating in the training were managers and kitchen staff in the food service industry, (restaurant, hotel, canteens and chop bar) and the media; with the keynote address being delivered by the Regional Director of the Ghana Tourism Authority (GTA), Mr. Moses Ndebigri.

Participants indicated their appreciation for the training and requested for more of such training and the need for extension of same to other Districts.
