

## **FDA ARRESTS FAKE PRODUCER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

The FDA, on the 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2017, arrested a producer of fake alcoholic beverages upon a tip off from a member of the Public. The informant alleged that, the producer was producing fake alcoholic beverages at Darkuman, behind the Union Oil Filling Station.

A team, made up of Officers from the FDA and the Ghana Police, went to the facility of the alleged fake producer as a follow up to the information received.

Some of the products found to have been faked included Joy Daddy Bitters, Adonko Bitters, Amingo Ginger Bitters amongst others.



The FDA seized all finished products and packaging materials found at the premises.

The suspect, Mr. Franklin Crentsil, was arrested and is currently at the Nima Police station assisting with further investigations.



The FDA would like to take this opportunity to warn perpetrators of Fake Concoctions and preparations to desist from these dangerous activities as it can lead to health hazards or compromise health and safety.
