PUBLIC NOTICE FOR WATER PRODUCERS

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Food and Drugs Authority (FDA) by Section 81 of the Public Health Act, 2012 (Act 851) to provide and enforce standards for the sale of food, the Authority issues this directive to all non-retail producers and manufacturers of bottled and sachet water.

Concerns with the current state of affairs where vital product information on primary and secondary labels of bottled and sachet water is not identical have necessitated the introduction of these additional requirements.

The FDA issues this directive in order to ensure the public's access to and easy identification of all essential product information at the point of purchase and to facilitate effective post-market surveillance.

All producers and manufacturers are therefore requested to take note of and comply with the following additional requirements:

1. All labelling information on both primary and secondary packaging should be the same.
2. The name and contact details of franchisee(s), where applicable, should be on the front of the pack or on the principal display panel of the secondary package as well as the primary package.
3. The font size on the product label should be at least half of the size of the largest font on the label.

Please note that this directive takes effect from **1st October, 2019**.
