Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by a new virus that had not been previously identified in humans. It spreads primarily through contact with an infected person when they cough or sneeze, or through droplets of saliva or discharge from the nose.

Everyone is at risk of getting the coronavirus infection, especially those who recently returned to Ghana from any of the affected countries.






CORONAVIRUS SIGNS/SYMPTOMS

WAYS TO PREVENT CORONAVIRUS INFECTION


- Wash your hands frequently with soap under runny water
