1. WHAT RONVIT EXTRA AND WHAT IT IS USED FOR

Pharmacological Classification: Pharmacotherapeutic group: Antihistamine & Appetizer

ATC code:- R06AX02

Cyproheptadine is a serotonin and histamine antagonist with anticholinergic and sedative effects. Antiserotonin and antihistamine drugs appear to compete with serotonin and histamine, respectively, for receptor sites.

Indication:

Combination of Cyproheptadine and multivitamins provides quick recovery from allergic disorders, treatment of inflammation of nasal mucosa such as rhinitis.

Nutritional deficiencies, diet regulation in the course of treatment are corrected by the vitamins.

Cyproheptadine is indicated in the treatment of

- Perennial and seasonal allergic rhinitis
- Vasomotor rhinitis
- Allergic conjunctivitis due to inhalant allergens and foods
- Mild, uncomplicated allergic skin manifestations of urticaria and angioedema
- Amelioration of allergic reactions to blood plasma
- Cold urticaria
- As therapy for anaphylactic reactions adjunctive to epinephrine and other standard measures after the acute manifestations have been controlled.

Vitamin A corrects the nutritional deficiency, promotes growth and enhances vision, treats skin disorders.

Vitamin D3 used in the treatment and prevention of Vitamin D deficiency, hypocalcaemia associated with disorders such as hypoparathyroidism.





Vitamin B1 is an essential coenzyme for carbohydrate metabolism. Treatment of deficiency disorders such as beri-beri, Wernicke-Korsakoff syndrome.

Riboflavin is required for the utilization of energy from food, treatment of nutritional deficiency, glossitis, keratitis, seborrhoeic dermatitis.

Nicotinamide is used in the treatment and prevention of deficiency, in conjunction with lipid regulating agents in hyperlipidemia, in alcoholism.

Calcium Pantothenate is a nutritional supplement and usually used in conjunction with other B group vitamins.

Calcium lactate is used in calcium deficiency states resulting from dietary deficiency or aging.

2. BEFORE YOU TAKE RONVIT EXTRA

Antihistamines should not be used to treat lower respiratory tract symptoms including those of acute asthma. Benign Prostate Hyperplasia, lactation, epilepsy, alcoholism. Cyproheptadine is not recommended in new born and premature infants and in nursing mothers because of the higher risk of antihistamines for infants generally and prematures in particular. Cyproheptadine is not recommended in debilitated elderly patients.

Drowsiness is encountered following oral administration of Cyproheptadine. Caution should be exercised during driving activity.

3. HOW TO TAKE YOUR MEDICINE

As directed by the physician. Dosage should be individualized based on the needs and response of the patients.

4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

Sedation and sleepiness (often transient), dizziness, disturbed coordination, confusion, , excitation, nervousness, tremor, irritability, insomnia, paresthesias, neuritis, convulsions, euphoria, hallucinations, hysteria, faintness.

5. HOW TO STORE RONVIT EXTRA

Store in a dry place below 30°C. Protect from light, heat & moisture.
KEEP MEDICINES OUT OF REACH AND SIGHT OF CHILDREN.
