

PUBLIC NOTICE

RENEWAL POLICY FOR FDA APPROVALS

The Food and Drugs Authority (FDA) has revised its processes for the renewal of registrations and approvals for regulated products and licenses issued by the Authority.

In view of the above, manufacturers and importers of FDA regulated products are to note the following:

- Renewal of all product registration and facility licences must be initiated three(3) months before the validity period expires
- 2. Renewal dates will take effect from when the last approval date expires. For example, if the last approval date for a product expires on 12/12/21 and the importer renews registration on 02/02/22, the approval still takes effect from the day after expiry which was 13/12/21
- 3. An applicant who does not wish to continue marketing a product or is suspending manufacturing processes, should

communicate its intention to discontinue the registration of a product and/or closure of its facility, at least 3 months before the validity of the certificate or license elapses.

The FDA during this festive season is alerting the public to be extra vigilant to ensure that products purchased are of good quality and within the best before or expiry dates.
